Studieår 2016/17

- 1. september - 15. september – Introforløb for studerende fra Fashion Design Akademiet
- 16. september - 20. december – Efterårssemester
- 16. januar - 5. maj – Forårssemester

Priser:

Obligatorisk introforløb:

600 Euro = ca. 4.500,- kr. for 14 dages fransk undervisning, intro til modemiljøet i Paris og indkvartering via akademiet i de 14 dage introforløbet varer.

3. År – efterår og forårssemester på Paris American Academy:

8.000 Euro = ca. 60.000,- kr.

Introforløb og 3. år i alt 8.600 Euro = ca. 64.500,- kr.

Betales således:

- 1.600 Euro = ca. 12.000,- kr. i depositum ved tilmelding.
- 3.000 Euro = ca. 22.500,- kr. i slutningen af august (inden start)
- 4.000 Euro = ca. 30.000,- kr. i slutningen af december

Udover undervisningsafgiften, skal de studerende selv afholde alle udgifter til deres projekter, boligudgifter osv.

Below you see the topics of the 3rd year program:

- Sewing/Haute Couture III
- Flat Pattern/Draping III
- Fashion Design III
- Textiles III (including knowledge about various kinds of printing techniques + general knowledge about knit and knitting techniques)
- Costume Research III
- Personal branding and marketing
- Fashion History III

The third year program also include French as a Foreign Language.

All programs are taught in English, as Paris American Academy receive students from all over the world. During their studies, students can benefit from French language course integrated into the programs. The bilingual tradition of their academy almost every year groups together more then 20 different nationalities.

Supplies are not included in the tuition fee

Stationary and art supplies are more expensive in Paris than in other major cities worldwide and you are advised to bring with you as much as possible, without encumbering yourself unduly. Paris American Academy estimate the full cost of materials for an Academic Year for students in Fashion to be approx. 800 euros. You may qualify for 5 % to 15 % discount in certain art shops upon presentation of the PAA Student Card. Rather than having you buy books, Paris American Academy encourages you make use of the wealth of public libraries which abound in Paris.

Average living expenses in Paris for an academic year

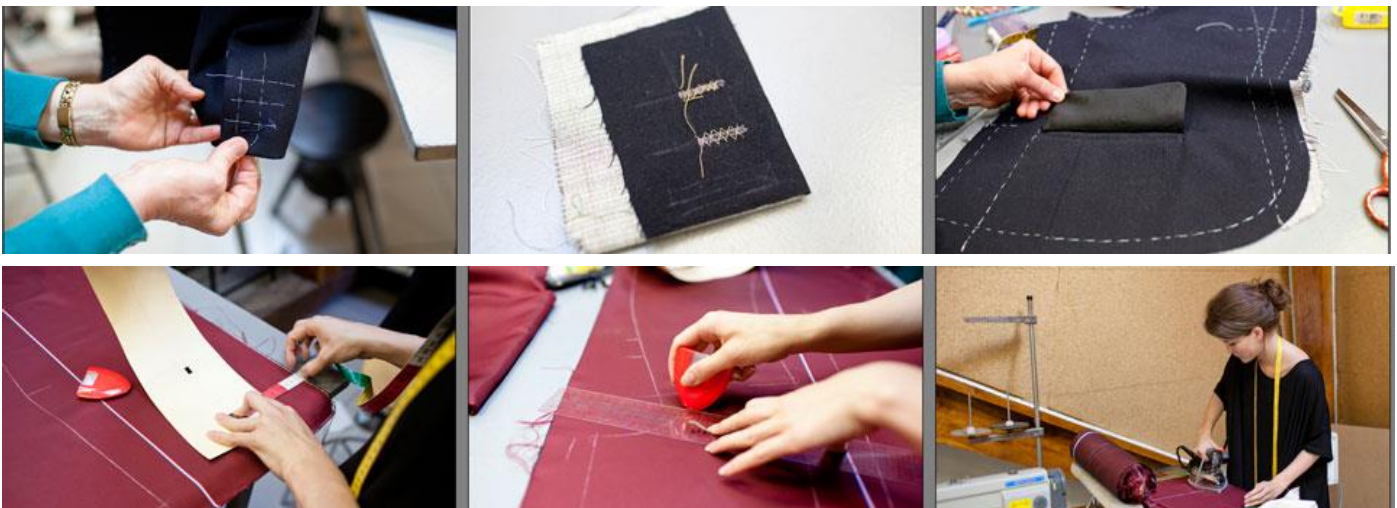
Expenses will vary depending on each student's living and spending habits. Below is a brief breakdown of an average expenditure per month indicated in EUROS.

School provided housing : 800 – 1.100 (lodgings in shared apartment)

Groceries : 400

Transportation : 65

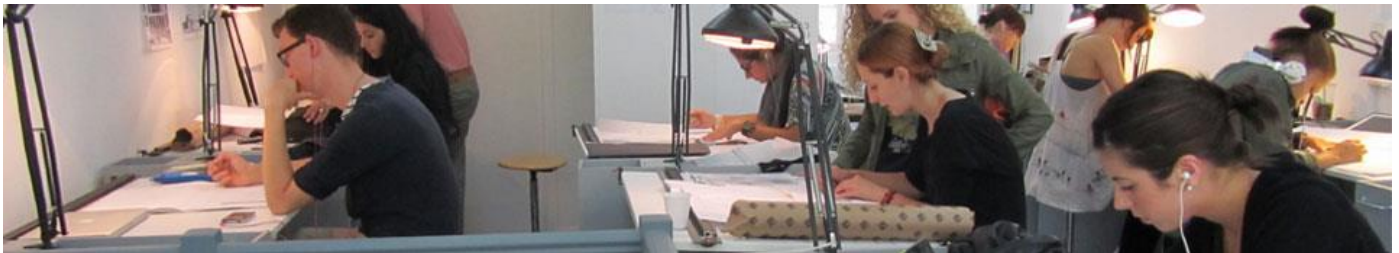
Health Insurance : Must be purchased to qualify before arrival in France.

The students and learning environment

Paris American Academy welcomes participants regardless of age, race, nationality, religion or political persuasion. Students benefit from a personalized learning environment created by a student instructor ration of one to five and small class numbers. This ensures for a flexibility of instruction, impossible at large institutions. Classes are mainly held in the Pavillon du Val de Grâce, a 17th century, historically classified building. Recently renovated, this six level edifice also serves as the Academy Art Gallery. Other studio space and administration offices are located in adjacent buildings.

The Paris American Academy

The Paris American Academy was founded by Richard Roy in 1965. During the past forty years, students and professions from thirty five nationalities have participated in either the intensive short term seminars or attended a longer four month Spring term or a three year curriculum. The strongly vocational approach prepares students for careers in Fashion, Fine Arts and Interior Design.

The Paris American Academy is registered by the Académie de Paris, as a private institution of higher learning under the 12 July 1875 jurisdiction. Centered less than a kilometer from Notre-Dame cathedral in the famous Latin quarter, the Academy draws upon Paris' cultural and artistic heritage in making the city it's campus.

The Paris American Academy has formed a unique teaching staff comprised of academics, skilled professionals, and invited guest artists. Thus providing students with a solid practical approach to professional requirements.
